User Skill Sets

Each Story Editor permission level has a different skill set requirement. Here are some things to consider when evaluating who to assign user permissions to in your organization:

Viewer: anyone (no specific skills required)

Content: familiarity with content media (image / video / copy) and brand standards (adjust fonts / color palette). This role would typically fall to the organization's Marketing Manager, Marketing Coordinator, Content Creator, or someone with similar experience in brand content.

Editor: familiarity with web development and CSS, HTML. This role understands how to layer content and link actions to pages.

Owner: the creators / owners of Story. No specific skills required; this person has full control over who can access Stories, and is the only person who can delete Stories.
